

## Geomatics Technologist

### Responsibilities

### Requirements and Qualifications:

- Minimum two (2) year diploma in Surveying or related discipline such as Geomatics, engineering or equivalent in experience.
- Extensive knowledge of GPS surveying methods (Static, rapid static, RTK) and use of total stations.
- Working knowledge of the application of geospatial tools (Drones, 3D Scanners etc) in topographic surveying, as-built monitoring and cadastral surveying.
- Competency in the use of Geospatial software including but not limited to, ESRI suite, FieldGenius, Carlson, AutoDesk and others is an asset.
- Experience with Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) and 3D modelling are an asset
- Experience with building information modelling (BIM) and image processing software such as Pix4D and Autodesk Revit are an asset
